Area Boards Meeting

The next Area Board meeting will be 26th June 2024 in Clyffe Pypard and Bushton Village Hall.

A grant was awarded to co fund delivery of detached youth work in Lyneham via Rise Trust in response to a reported increase in ASB.

Local Highway and Footway Improvement Group (LHFIG).

The next meeting will be 22nd May 2024, at the Lime Kiln Centre, RWB

Requests submitted from across the Community Area will be looked at to arrive at a "long list" of issues, which will then be further evaluated for final go ahead with finance from this year's allocated budget.

Community Safety Forum

Banking Hub

A date has been set for a 3 month review of the hub. Many people have asked for a cash point there. I will be pushing again for this addition.

A proposed scheme has been shared with me and the Parish Council for pedestrian crossing improvements outside the Co-op in Lyneham. I have expressed my concern about the removal of parking space at the front of the shop and am awaiting feedback.

This application has not yet been determined.





Following a thorough procurement process, Wiltshire Council has announced its intention to award the contract to rebuild the B4069 at Lyneham Banks, along with significant drainage works, to Octavius Infrastructure Limited.

Work on site is due to begin in summer 2024 and the council expects the road to reopen in spring 2025.

Once the B4069 has reopened, the council will be undertaking repairs to the local road network, which has been subject to increased traffic during the closure of the road.

I am pushing for early engagement with the Contractor to ensure that the voice of the local communities who will be directly affected by the construction project will be heard.
