Following my conversation with Frank yesterday. The purchase from the Woodland Trust of 105 tube protectors for the sapling trees which includes stakes and ties would be £350. Postage is free.

For information the Trees will arrive with a simple spiral protection which would be sufficient in protecting the samplings from small annimal's ie Rabbits, however without the tube guards, deer could possibly write off the whole batch.
