Costings for planters for spring/summer 2021 – all items from Greatfields

The prices are estimates, but I would not expect there to be a major difference within a few weeks' span.

I have concentrated on Mediterranean style shrubs that are relatively drought resistant and the bedding plants will hopefully be busy lizzies and marigolds, both of which prefer a dry soil, thus lessening the need for watering.

Some planters already have perennials that have survived well, some have none at all.

Melsome has no evidence of shrubs or perennials so will need planting

Victoria Drive has 2 planters that need complete replanting. There are no daffodils unlike the other planters so later in the year these will need planting to match the other ones in the village.

The Public Toilet planters will need replanting. 2 hanging baskets to be supplied,

Barry Holman has quoted £60 for planting the planter opposite Church Farm with shrubs and bedding plants, and looking after it.

Jenny May and Hazel will plant and care for the two beds at Church Farm Mews. They only require compost.

The Lyneham Roundabout Planters only require compost.

Bradenstoke Hollow Way require some infilling and a few more shrubs.

Bradenstoke Brook Lane need planting.

Bradenstoke Noticeboard need planting.
