8. For what purpose or project is the grant requested? *

Let's Get Gardening Project, will be delivered by the CDW at the 5Bn REME Welfare House, Weekly from 20th April 1530-1630. This project runs straight after school providing families with recreational activities outside to improve both wellbeing, socialisation and nature based practice. Once month this project will run from 1000-1200 on a Saturday for families who maybe unable to attend during the week and to complete longer projects. Project based work will include; cleaning and clearing the planters, making bird feeders, planting new plants, creating signs for plants, nature hunts, bug hotels, watering and maintain plants, checking for damage or rot and mitigating the risk, supporting biodiversity and creating additional projects to facilitate the wider nature community. At the end of the project the garden will opened for a Garden Party to show off the achievement of the families. The cost of the project will be to cover the purchase of gardening equipment, seeds and bulbs, and resources to maintain the garden.
