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# **Summary of Public Participation Section**

Parish Council Chairman, Cllr. Frank Ball opened the meeting and invited participation from the public.

#### **Report from Wiltshire Council**

FB updated AB that the Parish Council has had issues with Wiltshire Council regarding the Neighbourhood Plan and the lack of support and help. The Parish Council will continue to work with Wiltshire to attempt to resolve.

#### **MOD Lyneham Report**

Lieutenant Colonel Patey gave an update:

- We are looking to cut back the trees around the Pelican Crossing on the A3102 and have a meeting planned 18 Oct 23 with the Highways Agency. I believe a quick win would be putting a proper Pelican Crossing lights on the path rather than on lamppost in the bushes (see attached photo).
- Have we got any data on the IDS on the A3102 If the data shows speeding is happening then this should drive an increase in police surveillance. Moreover, it might be prudent to put the IDS on the other side of the road. Cars seem to speed up straight after the pelican crossing, especially if they have been frustrated by waiting at the choke point outside of camp.
- We have called the local Police for a meeting on the MQ estate (7 Oct 23) due to an increase in anti-social behaviour: fly tipping, drug paraphernalia found, vandalism, rowdy threating behaviour etc.
- Ash Die Back Avon Grove. Heartwood the DIO Contractors would like to make a start in the woodland on the 16 October 23. They need to get in there before the weather really turns nasty. Their managers will be down at Lyneham confirming the access routes and liaising with the neighbouring landowners to ensure that we have everybody on side in order to minimise any chance for the Army to again become embroiled in the works. This should be a lot easier to control as the methodology will be to lift the wood over the security fence and exit through the camp. The pathway will need to be close during the period of works.
- MOD Lyneham Bonfire Night (1 Nov 23) posters have gone out and delivered around the local houses.
- The MOD will be sending representatives to both Lyneham and Bradenstoke churches. An officer will be present to lay the wreath along with some soldiers.



- There will be a remembrance service and parade held outside the museum on the Sunday and the public are invited to attend.
- There has been reports of anti-social behaviour on the estates and the Police are working with the MOD. There will be an increase in guard patrols.
- There is an ongoing commitment for Lillybrook Estate to help move the homes. This will continue.
