Introduction

Area Boards are a way of working to bring local decision making into the heart of the community. There are 18 Area Boards across Wiltshire and the Royal Wootton Bassett and Cricklade Area Board covers 13 Parish and Town Councils including Cricklade, Lyneham and Bradenstoke, Purton, Royal Wootton Bassett and Tockenham.

In January 2022, the Area Board set up The Community Care Group to support older and vulnerable people and their carers. Representatives from all towns and parishes in the community area were invited to attend the first meeting to discuss priorities. The result of this was that communication, or lack of it, was a common priority with the group of representatives that participated.

A project was then put forward to produce an information booklet covering the five participating communities. This booklet contains a list of social activities in each community (to the best of our knowledge at the time of going to print) and general information on support organisations.

Community groups can apply to the Area Board for funding (grants) to help support their project, for more information contact your local Wiltshire Councillor, please find their details on p3.

Thank you to many volunteers who generously gave their time in researching the information.

Tockenham

Tockenham is a very small parish of approx. 110 homes lying on either side of the A3102 between Royal Wootton Bassett and Lyneham. It spreads from the North of the A3102 with Tockenham Wick and The Hillocks, all the way South to Greenway - on the road to Bushton. The core of the village lies in the middle of these outlying areas – approx. 3/4 mile from the main road.

Here you will find the main facilities – a 17th Century church - St Giles, a Village Hall and an outside Play Area with play equipment and open space. All activities are centred in this area in Orchard Lane.

Activities include:

- Church services usually twice a month
- The bar is open in the Hall from 8pm on a Saturday
- A Coffee Morning is held in the Hall from 10.30 am on the first Tuesday of the month
- Social Events are organised in the Hall every 2 months or so
- Special Services are held in church periodically – e.g. Carol Service etc.
- The village holds an annual, traditional Village Fair
- The Hall is available for public hire

Unfortunately there is no regular bus service to the village itself and we have no car park.
