- 2. Nomination papers must be hand delivered to the Returning Officer, during office hours between 10am and 4pm Monday to Friday, on any day after the date of this notice but must be received no later than 4pm on Friday 13 September 2019.
- 3. Nomination papers must be hand delivered only to the following locations:

 - Please ask for a member of the Electoral Services Team on arrival or
 - Main Reception at Council Offices, Monkton Park, Chippenham SN15 1ER.

- 4. Please note that nomination papers MUST be received within the statutory timescales stated and hand delivered only or they will not be accepted. Nomination papers received through the post or by electronic means will NOT be accepted and will be deemed as not received in the prescribed manner.
- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 10th October 2019.
- 6. Applications for postal and postal proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Wiltshire Council, County Hall, Bythesea Road, Trowbridge, Wiltshire, BA14 8JN by 5pm on Wednesday 25 September 2019.
- 7. Amendments or cancellations to existing postal, postal proxy and proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Wiltshire Council, County Hall, Bythesea Road, Trowbridge, Wiltshire, BA14 8JN by 5pm on Wednesday 25 September 2019.
- 8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Wiltshire Council, County Hall, Bythesea Road, Trowbridge, Wiltshire, BA14 8JN by 5pm on Wednesday 2 October 2019.
- 9. A person can apply to vote by 'emergency' proxy if they learn they cannot go to the polling station because of their occupation, service or employment, or a medical condition, illness or disability arises after 5pm on Wednesday 2 October 2019. The application must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Wiltshire Council, County Hall, Bythesea Road, Trowbridge, Wiltshire, BA14 8JN by pm on Thursday 10 October 2019.
- 10. Parish/Town Councils must decide whether poll cards are sent when an election is requested and a poll is held. It is not a legal requirement to send poll cards.
