Provision of Christmas Holiday lights: A3102 Lyneham from St Michaels Church through to the roundabout at the Green.

The council to procure lights for each light stand on both sides of the road - 2 of per light stand.

The council to seek license from the County to so do.

The council to seek authority from the county to make electricity connection and modification thereof of each light stand to accommodate Christmas decoration.

The council to procure specialist contractor to assess requirement and make a defined statement of work to enable procurement activity.

The council to then enact procurement activity.

The successful contractor to supply, fit and set to work the decorations 14 days before Christmas and to uninstall lights 2 weeks after the new year.

The chosen lights are to auto start at dusk and cease at dawn.

The decision required of the council is to commence this project or not in order to define costs for further approval.

The decision of the council, should it proceed, is to have this defined fully and procurement completed before November in order to enable this by this December holiday period.

The decision of the council, should it proceed, is to engage the public in a nomination event for a deserving someone to be recognised by the parish and have the honor of lighting the lights on or about the 11th of December.
