

Working Age Benefits

If the person is PAYE (directly employed)

Statutory Sick Pay (SSP)

If they cannot work due to having Coronavirus and their employer is not going to pay, they MAY be entitled to Statutory Sick Pay.

They must apply at <https://www.gov.uk/statutory-sick-pay/eligibility>

Universal Credit

If they have been released from work, laid off or made redundant by their employer they MAY be entitled to Universal Credit, which will give an allowance to cover some living expenses and a payment towards their rent.

They must apply at <https://www.gov.uk/universal-credit>

If the person is Self Employed

Self-employment Income Support Scheme

If you're self-employed or a member of a partnership and have lost income due to coronavirus.

Currently they cannot apply, and normally they will be notified but HMRC
