Oaks along dog field/MOD boundary.

Alder and walnut to fill gaps in planting.

3 firs along playing field/dog walking field.

It was agreed that the project would be an agenda item at PC meeting 15th September 2020, for approval of project and public consultation previously circulated.

Public consultation publicised on village noticeboards, PC website and facebook pages. 1 week duration.

Group to consider any responses to public consultation and a project plan be presented to Parish Council meeting in October 2020 for approval.

Hopefully, weather and Covid 19 guidelines permitting, an event at end of October 2020 to plant the trees.

Design of plaque commemorating the purpose of tree planting to be carried out at a later stage.
