A member of the public asked a question regarding the difference between the fibre internet offered by Gigaclear and that already on offer in the village. Cllr Ball replied that, according to the presentation, the speeds offered by Gigaclear are around 10x that currently available as this would be pure fibre to the premises rather than fibre to the cabinet (coupled with copper to the house).

Cllr Bucknell added that Wiltshire Council has been working to get better broadband rolled out to Wiltshire to attempt to ensure at least 95% have high speed access.

A member of the public asked whether the Council has certain roles for members. It was explained that the Council has policies in place to help run its business and a policy review committee. It doesn't always have the expertise but if it needs more expertise, it will go outside to find it.

A member of the public raised a concern on an area of land between Lyneham and Bradenstoke used as unofficial parking. Cllr Ball offered to go and look. Additionally, there are some signs that need attention.
