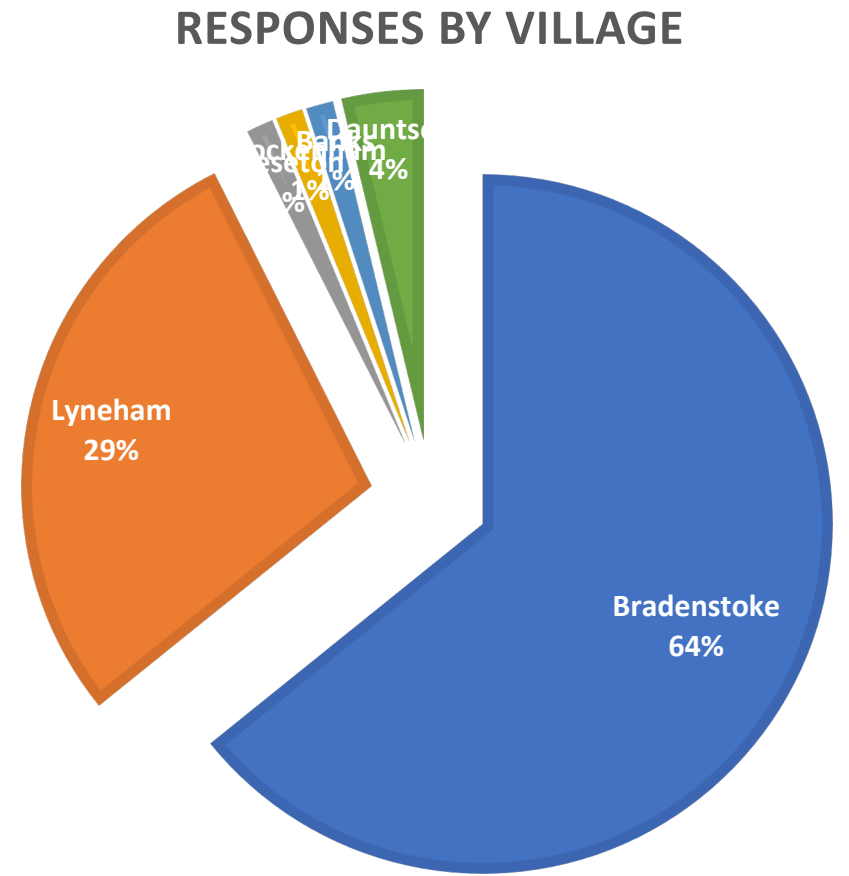


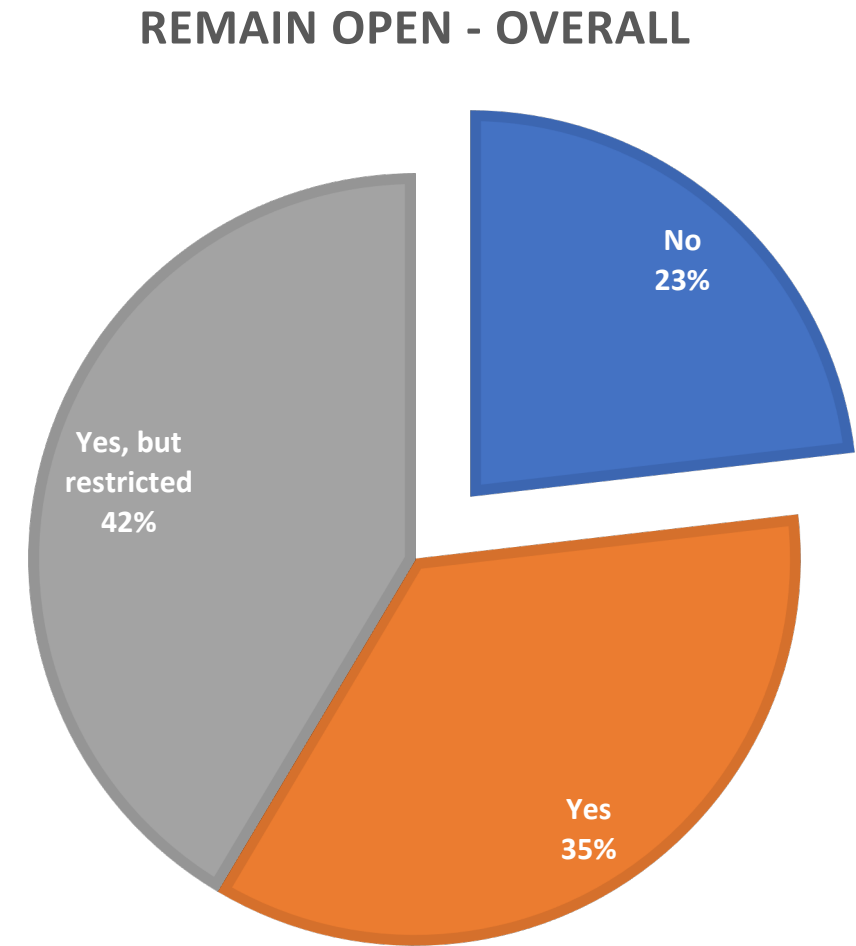
# Clack Hill Survey Responses

- 82 Responses
  - 52 from Bradenstoke, 23 Lyneham, 1 Tockenham, 1 Preston, 1 The Banks and 3 Dauntsey.
  - 88% of Bradenstoke Respondents were regular users of Clack Hill
    - Of these, 28% felt it should be closed, 24% felt it should remain open, and 48% felt it should remain open with restrictions.
    - The 12% who were not regular users were in favour 2:1 for it to be closed.
  - For Lyneham, 50% were regular users
    - Of these, none felt that it should be closed. 27% felt it should have restrictions.
  - Overall, 78% of respondents were regular users
    - 20% of these felt it should be closed, 39% advocated it being open, 40% felt it needed to stay open with restrictions.



# Clack Hill Survey Responses

- Of the 64 respondents using Clack Hill regularly
  - 26% used it for pleasure, the rest for work or related activities
  - 50% of the users advocating closure were pleasure users
- The majority of respondents advocating closure commented that the current signage was being ignored.
- A number of respondents commented that they use Clack Hill for medical appointments
- Overall, 23% of respondents wanted Clack Hill to close, 35% favoured being left open, 41% open with restrictions.



# Clack Hill Survey Summary

- Overall, 77% of those responding were **not in favour** of closure.
- The largest issue is not whether it is open or closed, it is the contravention of the restrictions by large vehicles and speeding.
- This is backed up by the direct emails received showing vehicles that should obviously not be using the road.
- With the potential time period being extensive, how can the Parish Council help have the restrictions enforced?

Responses were collected between the 19<sup>th</sup> April and 5<sup>th</sup> May
