

Lyneham & Bradenstoke Parish Council meeting 10th March 2019

Proposals for improved lighting at Bradenstoke Junction

I have reviewed the original idea and think we can deliver a suitable replacement scheme without having to dig up Chippenham Road or Hollow Way for a road crossing. Essentially the basic plan would be to install 3 units opposite to the junction but further apart to ensure an improved area of road is illuminated as well as improving lighting a little at the informal crossing point. All units will be maintenance friendly fold down columns and LED equipment to minimise the complexity of cyclic maintenance. See Plan A.

This option comes in around £4600. Please see the attached Bill of Quantity A.

The other option which I had in mind originally would be a more formal arrangement of units provide a high level of junction safety on approach along Hollow Way, but this would require a road crossing to Chippenham Road, take a longer duration on site to complete as well as being a more problematic to construct and more costly. See Plan B

This alternative option would be in region of £7700. See the Bill of Quantity marked Extended.

Both options are still estimates and would need TM design / quotation, and if taking up the extended option we would need to firm up the cost associated with the road crossing works.
