### **Bradenstoke – Traffic Management Options**

Following the road slip on the B4069 and the subsequent closure of this section of road in February 2022 the Council has been monitoring the impact of the traffic using Bradenstoke and other locations.

Traffic counters have been placed to capture speed, volume and type of traffic using local routes. Counts have been done in March and May and are due to be repeated again in September once the school term restarts.

The Council has received reports that due to the closure of the B4069, traffic issues are presenting on Hollow Way particularly around the junction of Clack Hill. This is due to queuing and congestion at the top of Clack Hill as there is insufficient width for two way traffic. There are also reports of aggressive driving and verbal abuse.

To try and help address the identified issues the Council has prepared a Traffic Management Options Note setting out further measures that could be introduced along with the positives and negatives for each option. The options set out are considered to be those that we can deliver. Some suggestions put forward have not been included of these are not legislatively possible and as such have been dismissed.
