1903854 Retrospective application for bund for visual reasons

Plan 19031 Green Farm application for up to 200 houses and some business use. Neighbourhood plan will have a plan and has an obligation to discuss and make recommendations whilst in the process. They did discuss proposed Gladman development. We are up to speed and have looked at the proposal and confirm that we can find no reason why support would be given. It falls foul of Wilshire strategies and there is no way the steering group could propose the planning application and the Parish Countil is to object. It does not meet any requirements. All Councillors voted against this.

#### 11. Neighbourhood Plan

This is at an advanced stage. We hold 2-weekly meetings in the Methodist Hall. Now close to completion and Consultants are to draft the document and send to the Parish Council. It then goes to Regulation 14 6-week publication . The public drop-in is Lyneham and Bradenstoke.
